KALISPELL- Flathead County Weed Department officials say they'll use a diver to pull invasive aquatic weeds found recently in Beaver Lake near Whitefish

The diver will pull the Eurasian Water Milfoil up from the bottom and then a bottom barrier will be installed in the area where the Milfoil was located to prevent further growth.

Eurasian Water Milfoil is a fast growing species that can easily take over entire lakes and destroy the ecosystem.
