## Trail work day

The Whitefish Lake Institute will hold a work day at the Living Wetland Interpretive Nature Trail on Saturday, June 11 from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Work includes trimming vegetation, weeding, repairing boardwalks, oiling wood surfaces, and removing debris. Volunteers should wear comfortable, moisture wicking layers, work boots, gloves and be prepared for changing weather. Bring a water bottle, sunscreen and mosquito repellent. Lunch will be provided with RSVP required by noon on June 8. Meet at the trailhead on Viking Creek Road on the east side of Wisconsin Avenue, just slightly south of The Lodge at Whitefish Lake.
