



Specialty License Plate Available!

How to purchase a Whitefish Lake Institute specialty license plate

Contact your county motor vehicle or treasurer and ask to purchase this specialty plate. The Flathead County Department of Motor Vehicles is located at 935 1st Ave W., Suite 7, Kalispell, MT and can be reached at 406.758.5690 for questions. To view the plate, go to <https://doj.mt.gov/driving/plate-designs-and-fees/parks-environment/>. Scroll down to Whitefish Lake Institute.

The plates are \$25. Your county treasurer will charge an additional one-time fee to cover administrative costs at the time of purchase. The plate will be automatically renewed each subsequent year after purchase. You do not need to wait until your annual registration renewal date. You can purchase the plate at any time, including when renewing your registration.

Why purchase a Whitefish Lake Institute specialty license plate?

Montana drivers can choose from a number of license plates, ranging from the standard plate to designs that reflect their support for special organizations and places. Your purchase of a Whitefish Lake Institute plate will provide you with a beautiful license plate and will support the only organization that's sole purpose is protecting Whitefish Lake. Part of the larger Flathead Watershed, Whitefish Lake is an important resource within and beyond the boundaries of Montana. Water from Whitefish Lake drains to Flathead Lake which then flows to the Columbia River Basin and toward the Pacific Ocean. Founded in 2005, the Whitefish Lake Institute is committed to protecting and improving the Whitefish Lake and Whitefish area resources of today, while providing a collective vision for tomorrow. WLI accomplishes its work through three key program areas, Scientific Research, Education & Outreach, and Community Stewardship. This specialty plate may be used on any registered vehicle with the exception of trailers, motorcycles and ATVs.
