Melissa is a Project Hydrogeologist with Water and Environmental Technologies (WET) specializing in groundwater and surface water investigations, stream gaging, water rights administration and all permits associated with Montana's Joint Application for proposed work in streams, wetlands, floodplains, and other water bodies.
