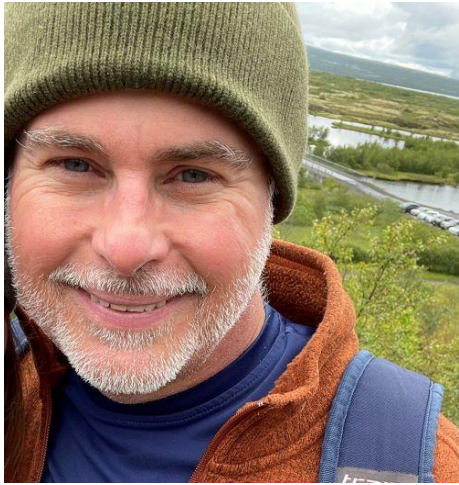

Todd Votteler

Todd H. Votteler, Ph.D. is President of Collaborative Water Resolution LLC, Editor-in-Chief of the Texas Water Journal and Texas+Water, and hosts the Talk+Water podcast. He is a Fellow of the Meadows Center for Water and the Environment at Texas State University (TxSt), a Mentor at the Austin Technology Incubator at The University of Texas at Austin, and an Executive Committee member for the Permanent Forum of Binational Waters.

Previously, Votteler was Executive Manager of Science, Intergovernmental Relations, and Policy at the Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority, Chairman of the Guadalupe Basin Coalition, Research Scientist in Washington, D.C. for the Battelle – Pacific Northwest National Laboratory, Executive Director of the Guadalupe-Blanco River Trust, and Chairman of the Texas Land Trust Council. In 1994, Votteler worked for the Court Monitor during *Sierra Club v. Babbitt*. In 1996, he was appointed Federal Special Master during *Sierra Club v. San Antonio*. In 2016, he negotiated a resolution to the conflict over surface water use and potential impacts to endangered whooping cranes.
