APPLICATION PROCESS

Scholarships are available to high school, college, young professionals, or lakeshore owners interested in attending the 2023 Montana Lakes Conference. The conference, to be held at The Lodge at Whitefish Lake in Whitefish, October 18-20, 2023, will gather participants to discuss scientific and applied studies addressing challenges facing Montana Lakes today, while sharing success stories and providing solutions for tomorrow. Through the conference you will have exposure to key scientists, cutting edge engineers, and water managers from across the state of Montana. Apply for this professional experience if your career and/or academic interests include lake, aquatic ecology, environmental science, biology and/or water conservation. (10 scholarships will be awarded: 5 to girls and women with funding support from Soroptimist, and 5 to other students and/or landowners with funding support from the Whitefish Community Foundation).

Scholarship & Internship Applicant Responsibilities

In addition to completing a Scholarship Application Form below, students must submit:

- A 300-word essay describing your “watershed ethic.” In short, what is your philosophy regarding human activities that affect water quality in Whitefish Lake or a watershed where you live? How will attending this conference advance your study and/or career in lake science, aquatic ecology, biology, water quality, or other environmental interests?

- Completed applications and essays for **Conference Scholarships** must be postmarked or emailed to the Whitefish Lake Institute on or before **August 15th**.
